

## **Voices of Freedom: Chapter 9**

### *Short Answer and Multiple Choice Practice*

#### **Instructions:**

1. Open "Voices of Freedom" to the table of contents. Review the contents and page numbers for CHAPTER 9.
2. Read the *Introductory/Context paragraphs* for ALL of the primary passages for CHAPTER 9.
3. Select ONE of the readings. Read it carefully. Take notes
4. After reading it, take out a blank piece of paper. Write the TITLE at the top of the page. Put your name and hour in the UPPER RIGHT corner of your paper.
5. Write ONE short answer question based on the main ideas and concepts that are discussed and referenced in the passage. Here's what needs to be included:
  - The question needs to have the student complete 3 tasks
  - They should reference some information that is not DIRECTLY mentioned in the passage.
  - Ideally, part of the question should ask for some higher level thinking skills.
  - Write legibly. If you cannot do this, type it.
6. Flip your paper over.
7. Write THREE multiple choice questions that go with the passage you read. Here are the rules:
  - Each question needs FOUR possible responses, the correct answer and 3 distractors (incorrect, but plausible responses).
  - The questions cannot DIRECTLY refer/ask about information that is contained within the passage. Instead, the questions should refer to the larger concepts and context that the passage is a good example of.
  - Write legibly. If you cannot do this, type it.
8. Your questions are due on MONDAY. This is a difficult task, good luck. Come prepared.
